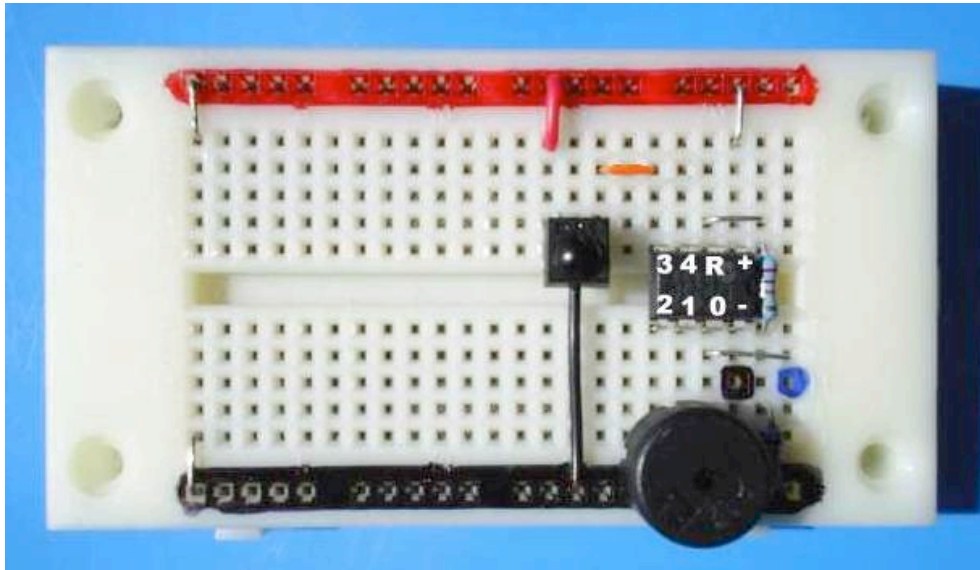


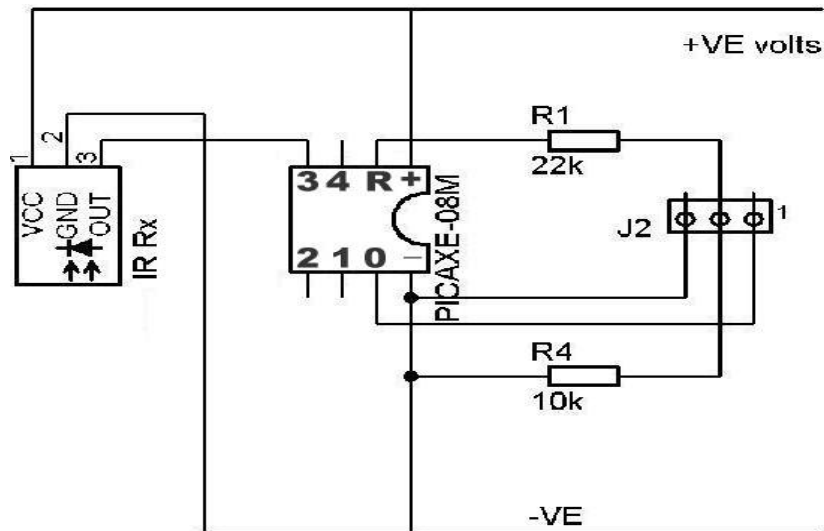
TV Ird Remote IR Serin Decoder



loopa:

```
serin 3, xxxx, b1, b2, b3 'Stop and read in three bytes of data from any Ird / TV remote
debug                    'Display three byte values on debug screen
goto loopa
```

Warning! Highly Experimental! Try different combinations of N and T 300, 600, 1200 in place of xxxx. E.g. serin 3, t600, b1, b2, b3 Press each remote button ONCE repeatedly to see what buttons produce a useful series of codes into b1, b2, b3. xxxx varies between make and model or remote but is quite consistent and can give good straight forward control of simple projects.



- Check also the infraout command that matches infrain2 and advanced M2 Irin commands that are already compatible with Sony TV remotes and Sony TV clone remotes
- A PICAXE-08M Infraout TV remote can be constructed at little cost to give direct IR control with 127 unique codes. See separate worksheet template
